

# Chalk It Up! CREWE Artists Terms & Conditions

Organised by UrbanCanvas and Cheshire East Council

**TOWN SQUARE, Crewe, England: Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> August 2017**

By filling in the enclosed application you agree to the following:

1: The intellectual property of the works produced during the event is owned by you the artist. However any photographs taken by UrbanCanvas or Cheshire East Council can be used with appropriate acknowledgements to promote the festival or other such appropriate activities as the organisers feel fit.

2: Artists will be given a free box of quality pastels on arrival; however you will be allowed to bring your own pastels to the event. These MUST be approved by us beforehand. Artists will not be allowed to use permanent paints, oil pastels or any such materials that are likely to damage the fabric of the site. Other techniques such as the use of 'sugared water', acrylic binders etc. must be approved in advance.

3: Artists will be allocated a pitch size of 12ftx16ft (approx. 4mx5.5m) on arrival. All work must be done within the boundaries of this pitch. Some allowances will be made dependent upon design and available space.

4: Artists are responsible for all their personal belongings, please make sure you keep them safe, UrbanCanvas or Cheshire East Council will not be responsible for any damage or loss. Personal items must be stored so as not to cause a public trip hazard.

5: Please be aware that this is a public event and as such artists will not be allowed to produce work that is in any way deemed to be offensive, racist, sexist or in any other way offends public decency.

6: Times of the event – between 10am and 6pm; artists are advised to arrive on site at least 45 minutes before the start time of 10am. Artists who arrive late may not be given a pitch.

7: Closing date for applications: **18<sup>th</sup> August 2017**. Places are limited. By filling in and returning your application you have agreed to appear at this event, if you fail to do so or inform us of your non-attendance at least 24 hours before the event you are depriving a fellow artist from taking part. Non-Attendance will exclude you from taking part in any future event or paid artist opportunity organised by UrbanCanvas. Application forms returned after the closing date will not be valid. An informal selection process will be made on applications. Filling in the form does not guarantee you a place. Applicants must be 18 or over. At least ONE hi-res image of your work must be included

8: Freehand drawing is preferred however stencils, pounces and any other pre-planned design works will be allowed as long as the final work is done directly onto the pavement. Finished work on paper or canvas will not be allowed. Refreshments will be provided during the event; artists will be allowed to leave their pitch for toilet breaks etc. but must inform a volunteer or organiser beforehand.

9: Artists are quietly invited to put out a hat for public appreciations but must not actively solicit or approach the public for money, artists doing so will be asked to leave. Please notify us if you intend to sell books, postcards or prints of your work during the event. You will be allowed to keep 100% of what you make.

10: Prize awards will be offered on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> August in the following categories: Original Art, Copy Art, and Peoples Prize award.

11: A prize giving ceremony with drinks and buffet will finish off the event.

12: The Judges decision will be final.
